Webber Jarrell born May 26, 1926 passed away August 6, 2012 at the age of 86 at his residence in Carriere, MS. He was a retired foreman with the L.S.U. Forestry Department, and also served as the Minister and member of Temple Baptist Church here in Bogalusa. Webber was also a Veteran of WWII and received a Purple Heart during his service in the United States Army.
