In lieu of flowers, the family has asked for donations to be made to the United Methodist Children and Family Services or Our Lady of the Angel Hospital.






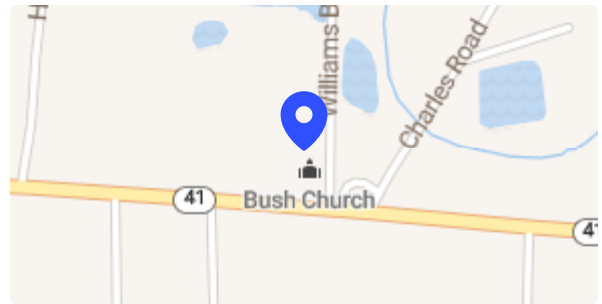

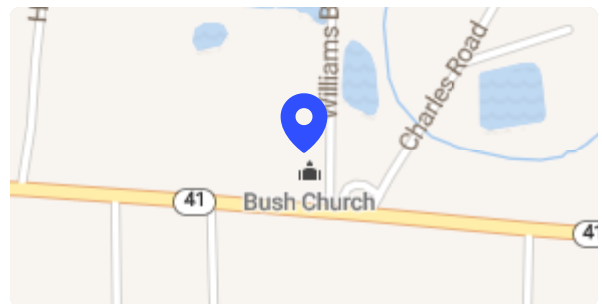
