A celebration of life with refreshments will follow after interment at Highland Baptist Church.



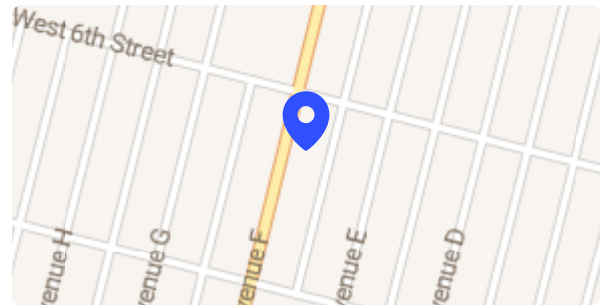

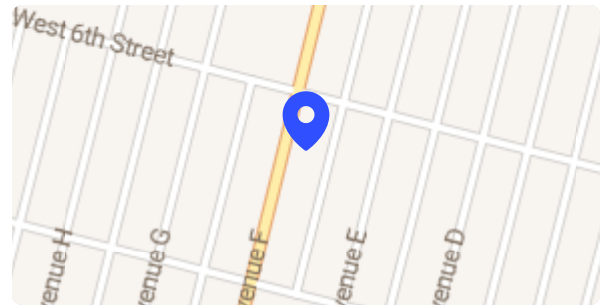
