Services will be officiated by Brother Doyle Ball.

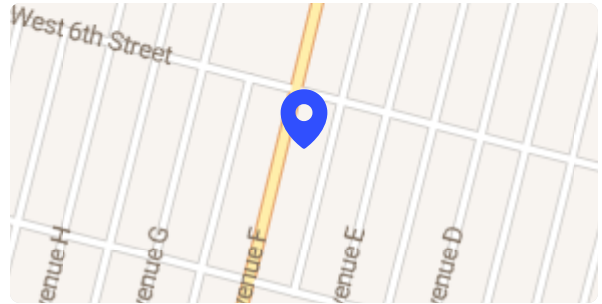

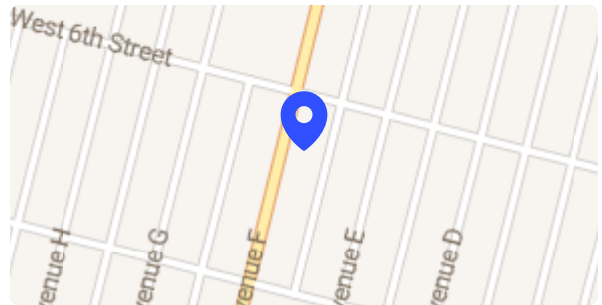
