On August 26, 2021, Mr. Lampton "LC" Terrell, 98, passed away at Oschner Hospital in Kenner, LA. Mr. Terrell retired from Bogalusa Police Department as an assistant chief of police and also served as a chief of police for Sun Police Department. "LC" was a Staff Sergeant in the Army, veteran of World War II, where he served his country and was part of D-Day in Normandy, France. One of his proudest accomplishments in World War II was storming the Utah Beach in Normandy, France.

He is survived by his two daughters: Joycelyn Terrell and Janice Foley; one grandson: Colin Byrd and his wife Tracey; one brother: Uberty Terrell; a son-in-law: Charles Locke; host of nieces and nephews; and numerous other family and friends.

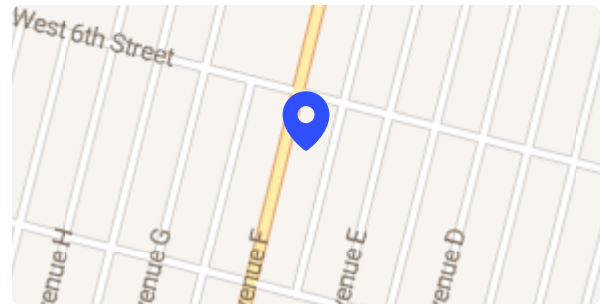

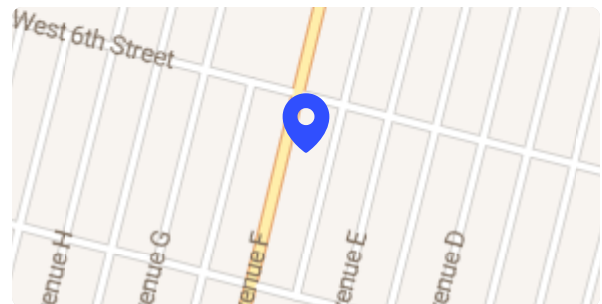
