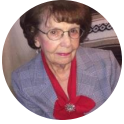
OCT 16, 1925 - JUL 2, 2024

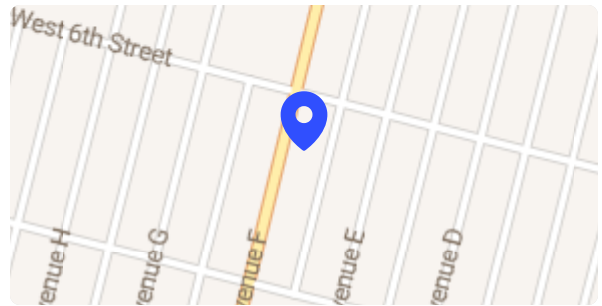

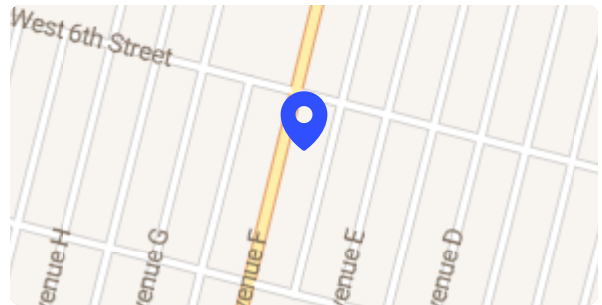

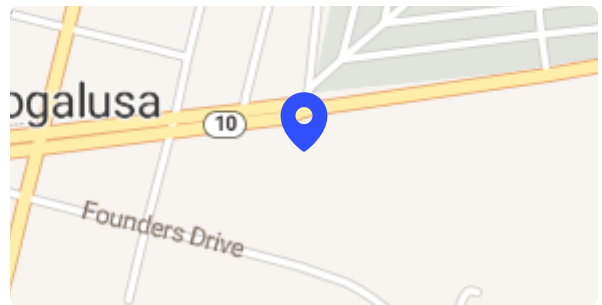
