He celebrated his 93rd birthday on Monday, June 30, 2025, and almost all his grands and great-great grands came and sang him happy birthday. He loved his family. He was a member of the Genealogy Society and very proud of his Scottish heritage. He was a member of the Sons of the American Revolution, and was on the St. Tammany Parish Library Board. He was an Army veteran, and began his long career in law enforcement walking a beat as a Baton Rouge city cop and was promoted to Juvenile Officer, followed by Detective where he was called “Goldfinger” because he liked to use gold fingerprint dust. Because of this, he was proudly given the badge number 007 upon his retirement from the City of Baker Police Department. He was also a Bush volunteer fireman. He was a life-long Methodist, who became a lay minister and Delegate entry for the Bush United Methodist Church. He loved taking kids on mission trips.

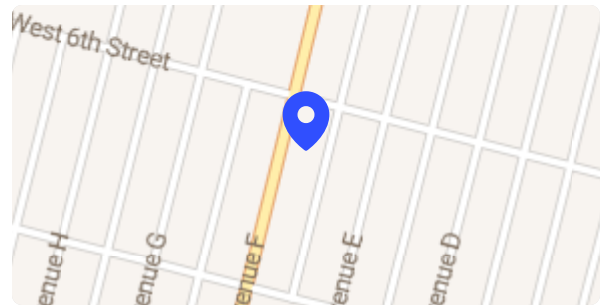

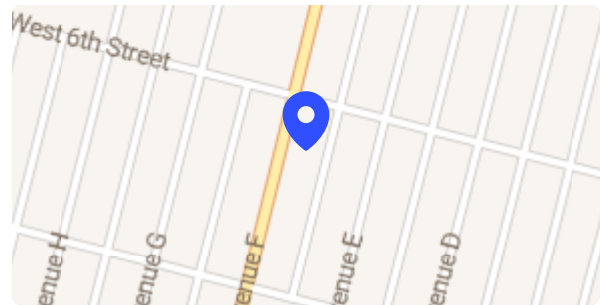

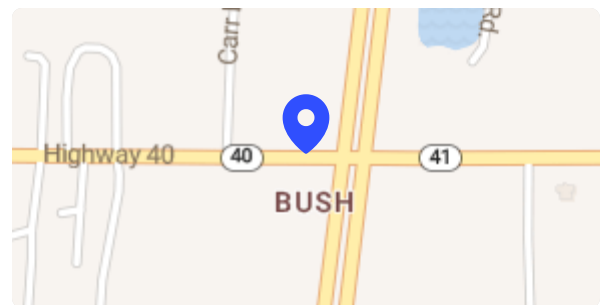
